

Fun Facts about Bamboo

Bamboo is divided into two major types: Running bamboo and Clumping bamboo.

Running bamboos can form the beautiful bamboo forest/bamboo sea that we often see in a movie.

Clumping bamboos' footprint expands slowly each year and usually in inches rather than feet.

Bamboo is a grass which can range from inches-tall dwarfs to giants towering more than 110 feet tall. Many clumping bamboos range 10-70 feet in height.

Bamboo is the fastest growing plant. Moso bamboo has been recorded to grow 35 inches in one day.

In well-established bamboo forests, a new shoot can grow to its full height in a matter of weeks, after which the culm will not grow taller or thicker.


If a bamboo culm gets cut, it will not grow taller, but leaf out on the existing culm.

Bamboo rarely flowers. Some varieties can take up to 120 years to flower. The parent plant often dies after flowering.
